The Johns Hopkins All Children's Hospital (JHACH) Department of Radiology in St. Petersburg, Florida is recruiting a fellowship trained adult or pediatric interventional radiologist to join our team of 9 radiologists. JHACH provides the full spectrum of radiology procedures on children of all ages. The Department of Radiology performed 79,000 exams last year. The interventional radiology section performed 2,100 procedures last year and provides full-time IR coverage. We are seeking a team oriented candidate with a passion for quality care, commitment to serving our patients, families, and clinicians. This physician will perform a broad range of pediatric interventional procedures on a daily basis including, but not limited to biopsies, drainages, ablations, venous access, joint injections, GU interventions, pain management interventions, thrombolysis, and sclerotherapy. A candidate with experience in vascular anomalies would be a valuable addition. The Johns Hopkins All Children's Vascular Anomalies and Birthmarks Program offers state-of-the-art, individualized care to patients, and we are the only health system on Florida's west coast with an on-site multidisciplinary team. The ideal candidate will have the requisite skills to support and assist in the continual development of this program.

Members of our team utilize state-of-the-art equipment in all modalities. The department operates 4 MRI scanners and two CT scanners including Siemens Force CT scanner allowing for the most cutting edge CT exams. The interventional suite uses a Siemens Artis-Zee bi plane angiography table with cone beam software.

Johns Hopkins All Children's Hospital is a 259-bed teaching hospital ranked by *US News & World Report* as a "Top 50 Children's Hospital". We provide expert pediatric care for infants, children, and teens in the community - and around the world - who are facing some of the most challenging medical problems. JHACH is a Level 1 Pediatric Trauma Center. With more than half of the 259 beds devoted to intensive care level services, JHACH is the regional pediatric referral center for Florida's West Coast. Physicians and community hospitals count on JHACH to care for critically ill patients and perform complex surgical procedures. Opportunities for research are available if desired. Rotating radiology residents from University of South Florida are in the department daily allowing for educational opportunities. Qualified candidates may be eligible for an academic appointment at Johns Hopkins University School of Medicine (academic rank is open and commensurate with experience).
